The Northern California Indian Development Council, Inc. (NCIDC) has been awarded a contract by the California State Employment Development Department - WIOA Division (EDD) to provide temporary job creation to assist in cleanup, repair and reconstruction of public and private nonprofit property damaged by the recent disasters.

**Summary of Duties and Responsibilities**

The Disaster Assistance Crew member is responsible for working alongside the other crew members in clearing/repairing fire damaged public and tribal lands; cutting and removal of burnt trees, roots and debris; Clearing irrigation ditches; culverts, roadsides, erosion bank stabilization; and the General Clean-up of Damaged Effected Areas on the public and tribal lands.

**MINIMUM Qualifications**

1. Must be considered "long-term unemployed" (15 weeks out of the last 26).
2. Meet all California State Employment Development Department – WIOA Division (EDD) eligibility guidelines.
3. Ability to understand and follow written and oral instructions.
4. Skill in the operation of equipment related to fire clean up.
5. Knowledge of safety rules and regulations governing fire repair work.
6. Ability and aptitude to work consistently in a professional manner.
7. Ability to work as a part of a crew positively.

**WORKING CONDITIONS AND PHYSICAL DEMANDS**

- Operating chain-saws, Green Machines, pole saws, picks, shovels, axes, rakes
- Sitting, walking, standing and bending for long periods
- Ability to lift up to 50lbs
