Dear Partner Tribes:

Effective immediately, CTTTP will be providing Non-Recurrent Short Term Benefits for the Pandemic Emergency Assistance Fund (PEAF). This assistance is available to current CTTTP participants and to CTTTP Partnership Tribal members who have at least one minor child residing in the home and must be enrolled or a descendent of federally recognized Tribal Partner residing in the CTTTP service areas.

The PEAF Benefit will be available **Wednesday, June 16, 2021** through **Friday, October 15, 2021**.

Current CTTTP Participants have automatically received the NRSTB Pandemic Emergency Assistance Fund 2021 and will not have to apply for this benefit.

Non-CTTTP Participants (Partner Tribal Members) will have to complete an application with a CTTTP representative to determine eligibility.

Please contact your local CTTTP office to inquire if your household may be eligible.

Eligibility for Non-CTTTP Participants (Partner Tribal Members)

Must meet each item of eligibility:

1. 300% Federal Poverty Limit, recent proof of income within the last 30 days.
2. One minor child in the family must be enrolled or a decedent of federally recognized Tribal Partner.
3. Living in County of Crisis served by CTTTP.
4. Partnership Tribal members will need to provide justification by completing PEAF Assessment.
5. Partnership Tribal members cannot receive funding from multiple TANF programs.

60 Month time limit does not apply to Partner Tribal Members

Needed documentation to determine eligibility: ID for Head of Household adult, Tribal verification of Partner Tribe, residence verification (utility bill, rental agreement, etc.), income verification, and Birth certificate for at least one eligible child living in the home.

300% Federal Poverty Limit
